2022.01.110 Public Participation

A member of the public raised her concern over the Devolution proposals.

Cllrs explained they had discussed the proposals but had not felt in a position to contribute to the consultation until they had more information.

There was a discussion about the difference between the forming of the Unitary Authority and Devolution. NYCC Cllr Baker explained her understanding on Devolution and explained the role of the new Mayor. She said that she did not feel the PC would have much involvement in the process.

22/02904/FUL	Twisted Automotive Limited	Retrospective application for the retention of six shipping containers for a temporary period of 12 months
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Councillors had no objections to this application.

22/02594/OUT	Land At York Road	Outline application (all matters reserved) for mixed used development of commercial and light industrial complex comprising of 1nr 40,000 sqft warehouse, 2nr 10,000 sqft warehouse and 4nr 3,500 sqft, along with drive thru coffee shop and 74 bed hotel with associated car parking and access.
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Councillors strongly objected to this application for the following reasons,

1. Principle of Development
2. Impact on the character and appearance of the surrounding area
3. Impact on nearby designated Heritage Assets
4. Technical concerns around flooding
