Cllr Baker explained that the roadworks on York Road would continue until the middle of March 2023. There were two meeting in the following week, one to finalise the Budget for 2023 where there is a £30m shortfall and Council Tax will increase by the maximum 4.99% The other meeting to finalise the constitution of the New North Yorkshire Council.
